

Pray for the Peace of Jerusalem October 5th & 6th, 2013

Romans 9:1-8; 10:21-11:5; 11:13-26

“I am speaking the truth in Christ – I am not lying; my conscience bears me witness in the Holy Spirit – that I have great sorrow and unceasing anguish in my heart. For I could wish that I myself were accursed and cut off from Christ for the sake of my brothers, my kinsmen according to the flesh. They are Israelites, and to them belong the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship, and the promises. To them belong the patriarchs, and from their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ, who is God over all, blessed forever. Amen.” Romans 9:1-5

- ❖ The church, at its inception on the Feast of Pentecost, was virtually entirely Jewish!
- ❖ God gave to the Jews His Word, His covenants, His prophecies, His promises!
- ❖ God chose the land of Israel:
 - Leviticus 25:23 “The land shall not be sold in perpetuity [eternity], for the land is Mine. ...”*
 - Psalms 85:1 “Lord, You have been favorable to Your land; You have brought back the captivity of Jacob.” (NKJV¹)*
 - Ezekiel 38:16 “In the latter days I will bring you against my land, that the nations may know me, when through you, O Gog, I vindicate my holiness before their eyes.”*
- ♦ When we talk about Israel, we are dealing with a people as well as a property given them by God.
 - Genesis 17:8 “And I will give to you and to your offspring after you the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession, and I will be their God.”*
- ❖ God warns *“I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.” Genesis 12:3*
- ❖ God calls His people to pray for the peace of Jerusalem.
